Summary

We discussed whether or not this impact group should remain a focused group or be considered in restructuring conversations and integrated into all work. Kelly believes access hasn't been a priority for partners. Access/inclusion should be embedded in principle but be responsive to issues.

We discussed the upcoming Comic Con event. Our Bus booked for 31st. Kelly running t-shirt printing station and what designs we would want to use.

The group spoke about under-engaged groups of YP: young (adult) careers, asylum seekers & refugees, cared for & care experienced, SEND, Youth Justice Service, supported housing, section 19 children, YP leaving mental health hospital beds (MTS), electively home educated & unschooled, YP in Sanctuary safehouses. Jo raised the idea for an 'Engagement Worker' whose role it would be to engage these specific groups of CYP with provision/services & Imagine This activity.

We spoke briefly about comms; SENDIASS will have a new website by September with a youth section including a focus on CYPs rights. Kelly also said that if we want the participation team at the council to share anything, to send it straight to jo.mair@torbay.gov.uk.
